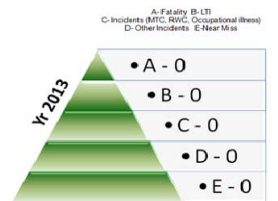
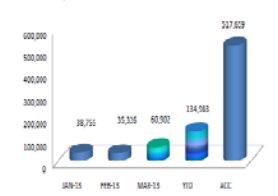


Vessel Mobilization

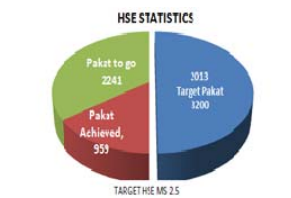
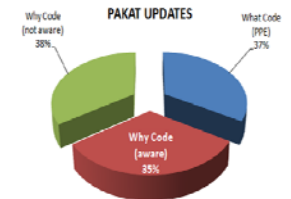
